

Regarding Approval LA19004 NW 33-7-26 W4M

Groundwater Monitoring Requirements

The purpose of this statement is to outline the monitoring requirements in Approval LA19004. Operating Condition #8 of Approval LA19004 reads:

Unless otherwise specified by the NRCB in writing, the leakage detection system as required by condition #5 above, must be kept accessible, and be maintained in operable condition, at all times. This system must be sampled by the co-permit holders in accordance with monitoring statement LA19004 MS Jul 19 In the event that damage to the liner is identified, or leachate is detected in the monitoring system, the NRCB must be notified immediately.

Monitoring Frequency

Bi-annual- with results submitted to the NRCB by September 30th and March 31st of each year

Monitoring Well Test Parameters

Presence of leachate in the monitoring detection system

Monitoring Wells to be used for Monitoring

Catch basin leakage detection system

The leakage detection system monitoring results must be forwarded to the Lethbridge NRCB office.

The integrity of the monitoring system must be maintained. Any damage to the catch basin liner or leakage detection system must be reported to the NRCB immediately.

These monitoring requirements become effective on the date of this letter and supersede any previously issued monitoring requirements at this facility.
