## Notice of Filed Requests for Board Review and Rebuttal Opportunity Decision Summary LA20014 / Hutterian Brethren Church of Granum

The Natural Resources Conservation Board (the Board) has received 13 requests for review (RFR) on NRCB Decision Summary LA20014. The decision summary, issued on August 26, 2020, approved a registration application for a new poultry confined feeding operation (CFO). The CFO location is SE 25-11-28 W4M in the MD of Willow Creek.

The RFRs were filed pursuant to sections 22 (4) and 22(5) of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA), and met the September 17, 2020 RFR filing deadline set out in the approval officer's cover letter to the decision summary. A copy of the RFRs received are attached.

Any party who believes they would be adversely affected by the position presented in the RFRs may submit a written rebuttal for the Board's consideration (section 13(4) of the AOPA Administrative Procedures Regulation). Rebuttals must be provided by email to <a href="mailto:laura.friend@nrcb.ca">laura.friend@nrcb.ca</a> no later than 4:30 p.m. on September 24, 2020. Rebuttals filed after the deadline will not be considered.
