My grounds for requesting a review of the Approval Officer's decision are as follows:

In the year 2018, Cypress County amended its Municipal Development Plan to require that "confined feeding operations are to be located where access to the site is to be gained from gravel, new high-grade roads or unless the confined feeding operator is willing to develop or upgrade the road to a gravel, new high-grade road at their own expense".

Under Sections 20 and 22 of the AOPA, an approval officer must consider whether the application is consistent with the municipal development plan land use provisions. Section 22, in terms of considering an application for an authorization, the AOPA grants an approval officer the ability to "impose terms and conditions on the authorization or amendment including the terms and conditions that a municipality could impose if the municipality were issuing a development permit".

Although there appears to be an inconsistency between Section 8.9 of the AOPA Operations Policy and Section 20 and 22 of the AOPA, the County is of the opinion that the NRCB in fact has sufficient authority to set the same type of conditions relating to upgrades and maintenance of County infrastructure by way that the decision would be consistent with the provisions of the County's statutory plans.

I believe that, as a result of the Approval Officer's decision, the following prejudice or damage will result:

Cypress County is inherently concerned with the impact Confined Feeding Operations have on our road infrastructure. Solely in consideration of application LA20035, Cypress County is aware that concerns have been raised by the operator pertaining to the condition of the roadways which currently grant access to this operation.

The approval officer has sufficient authority under Section 22 of the AOPA to impose conditions that are consistent with the County statutory planning documents.

This would allow for the resultant traffic from this operation to be directed to roads which are built to a standard to accommodate the type of traffic.
