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(#) Hutlerian Brethren Church of Little Bow face the loss of existing quatas & associated income and contracts. (#2) The future of not only livestock operation but also lively hood are directly effected. #3)

We feel that this is a special case the seneconstances and the concerns of all the parties involved should be heard and addressed accordingly.

(#3) It has been brought to the colony's attention that the quarters to the east and north are not in the exclusion zone and the colony may entertain the idea of relocating the barn to one of the quarters. However the quarters mentioned have irrigation prosts on them. And a transferr would result in a 10% loss of noter rights that cannot be replaced, as there are none available for purchase. There is also a substantial cost involved with putling in a new pipeline to a different parcel of land. which deems this a less than ideal option.

(#4) The last and possibly most concerning consideration we would like to bring to the approval officers altertion is how this decision effects the colony's agricultural and livestock operations in the future as this exclusion zone is in direct conflict with with all existing CFO's at that location and any possibility of expansion. However we also understand the importante of potecting the environment and ratural resources and look forward to addressing this with all the parties effected.

(#) Hutterian Brethren Church of Little Bow was re-located to the current location by the provincial Government in 2002. The Colony had minimal input in reguards to where the colony was to be re- Beent established. Therefore we feel it is important for the approval officer to take into Consideration that the government and local planning and development parties would have been in control of the relocation process and it's effects on the colony and it's agricultural and livestock operations in the future.

(#2) We would also like the approval officer to consider that Hutterian Brethren Church of Little Bow face loosing some and possible all their owned layer quota, because the caging system no longer meets industry standards and is considered obsolete by the Egg Board of Alberta. Such a loss would have substantial finantial impact on the future of the operation. Little Bow Colony and the Egg Board of Alberta come to an agreement to in 2020 to give the operation until 2024 to meet the coging requirements. The Existing facility is deem too small to facilitate the cage upgrade and a new larger facility was needed. This provided the colory an oppertune time to apply for an expansion.
