NRCB Inspector Karl Ivarson and NRCB Field Services have received the panel's decision dated October 14, 2021, which suspended the operation of Enforcement Order EO 21-01. We have marked EO 21-01 as "suspended" on our website.

In the decision letter, the panel wrote that EO 21-01 is suspended until NRCB Field Services has issued its formal grandfathering determination on the Mossleigh feedlot.

Enforcement Order EO 21-01 makes reference to a "grandfathering determination being made in conjunction with a permit application at this feedlot." The RFR filed by JS&S also references an application to expand the Mossleigh facility, which will including an "official capacity determination" (p 2 of RFR). The permit application referred to is LA21035.

I wanted to advise the panel that, on October 9, 2021, JS&S requested that the approval officer postpone their decision on application LA21035. As such, it is not certain when NRCB Field Services will issue its formal grandfathering determination on the Mossleigh feedlot.
