Notice Filed Request for Board Review and Rebuttal Opportunity Decision Summary FA21002 Hutterian Brethren Church of Cleardale

The Board of the Natural Resources Conservation Board has received one request for review (RFR) on NRCB approval officer's Decision Summary FA21002, issued on October 12, 2022. That decision denied an application by the Hutterian Brethren Church of Cleardale for an Approval to expand its confined feeding operation (CFO) to 6,000 beef finishers, permit previously constructed pens and catch basin, and construct new pens and catch basin. The CFO is located at SW 32-84-9 W6M in Clear Hills County.

The RFR filed was from the Hutterian Brethren Church of Cleardale, and met the November 2, 2022 deadline set out in the approval officer's decision letter. The RFR is publicly available on the NRCB website project page.

Any directly affected party who has an **adverse** interest to the outcomes requested or positions presented in the RFR may submit a written rebuttal letter or email for the Board's consideration [see section 13(4) of the AOPA Administrative Procedures Regulation].
