The Colony, being self sufficient, is really no benefit to the community. They do not support many local businesses and do not need to hire any outside labour.

The value of our land will decrease as people do not want to buy so close to the feedlot.

Also, one of the biggest concerns is that the dugout, where we get our drinking water is right in the path of where they feed cattle in the spring and the run-off can contaminate our water.

As well, while reading the issues for review, it says, "the entire County of Clear Hills (including public lands) are an exclusion zone for CFOs." Why then are they even considering it.
