The purpose of this letter is to express our grave concern regarding the Van Huigenbos Farms' application to expand a confined feeding operation (CFO). The proposed CFO expansion plans will have a significant negative impact on the surrounding area.

The following issues are of primary concern:

- The significant impact on the water demand on Willow Creek and on the aquifer potentially 80,000 +/- gallons per day at anticipated capacity.
- 2. Contaminated above-ground water running downhill and contaminating Willow Creek.
- Large, shallow below-ground aquifer considered to be at high risk due to a low restrictive layer below pit run and gravel bed.
- 4. Many of the concerned owners also have livestock that require fresh, uncontaminated water.

Other factors that must also be seriously considered:

- Increased travel with subsequent degradation of a one-entry road not suitable for heavy traffic endangers public safety.
- Increased environmental impact on the local areas affecting acreage wells (72 wells).
- The proposed operation enlargement is extremely close to a densely populated area.
- Odour concerns close proximity to all concerned properties as well as Town of Fort Macleod.
- Dust and other airborne pollutants which increase the risk of airborne and other health concerns.
