Recently I became a proud Canadian Citizen for which I am very grateful. It allows me to express my honest and humble thoughts and feelings what I want to say that I did not could before. I politely want to mention, that putting in another gravel pit is just not fair as we already have six in our neighborhood.

We were promissed three times by RU. Council_no more. We live in a very dense area on the edge where they intend to put the Scott pit, just so meter away. about.

Laura, my name is Adri Edwards, Jam 86 years old and my husband Michael Edwards and I have lived here in this quiet Cul de Sac called Crestview Estates since 1984 on an acreage of 4.27. Jam now widowed Unfortunately Michael passed away 21 september 2021 Itthen was Covid time, but thankfully henever got the disease.

Michael was and has been "the man" who spend 30 plus years of his life resisting new gravel pits in our area to be build. He wrote Lons of letters to governments, councelors, doctors ministers, envirement, researchers, just because he wanted the Community around us to breathe fresh air and live their lives in an healthy envirement. The man was smart, had three University degrees. He has been successful all those years in keeping the new gravelpits away. The one in 1992 was defeated and again in 2010 The last one in january 2021 was complecated. We never had a chance to defend ourselves, or having our voices heard. We could send in letters, but not a 5 minute personal presentation to mD Councel. to oppose, because of Covid. Then some one suggested, we could be heard by doing Michael was already to sick to do one Iwanted to do it, however I had no idea whatto say as it was really Michaels business. But for his sake I had to try One by one (because of Covid) we could come to someone's garage. I didnot know any body. It took a lot of courage I wrote on a piece of paper what I wanted to say. Ilooked strait into the camera, and poored my heart out It was very emotional. I must have done ox, as later coming home Michael received a lot of complements from residents like:

TOMIKE

I want to thank you and Adri personally for all you've done and been through in this fight. There were a lot of great video presentations from residents, but Adri's stood out above all the rest. She brought tears to my eyes, thinking of all the two of you have been through Give her an enormous hug for me

Hello Mike, please pass on to Mrs Edwards: Herpresentation to RVC was absolutely wonderful. Spoken from the heart and we totally identified with it All the best.

Hi Mike. I hear your wife knocked it out of the park. with hervideo. I can't wait to see it Mike she did a wonderful job. Colleen and I were very impressed Tell her we'll done. Solaura, what I said in my video seem to have touched a lot of people, may be when you read it, you will find a soft spot in your heart and agree also. 30 january 2021. This is what I said Goodmorning every one My name is Adri Edwards, Jam 82 years old and probably one of the oldest residents in Bears paw. Wehave lived in Crest view Estates since 1984. We are deeply disturbed, angry even that Le High Hanson is trying for a third time to get approval for yet another gravel pit. This one letterly would come in our backyard. This goes to far and it is unacceptable. Hre six pits not enough? This is a residential area. People live here We are surrounded by many new communities. Councel refused the gravel compagnies twice They keep on coming back. They are not welcome They don't seem to understand No means No. Councel knows all about our complaints, as every body writes the same letters But I will tell you personally why I am so upset It is because of all the hard work we have put in our place year after year. If you let me explain in simple words what really bothers me, you will understand

Living on an acreage is hard work, but we chose this lifestyle for 36 years we worked our fingers to the bones We dragged wheel barrel after wheel barrel up and down the hills with dead branches to make a path through the bush We seeded the trails and moved them with our small tractor. to make it look like our own private "littlepark Along side we placed benches, lantarns and tuns of flowers, garden ornements, gnomes and all. Michael build retaining walls, flower and vegetable beds picknick tables, benches, balconies and decks Even a gnome house with shutters and barn doors, so that only our cats could go through and kept the coyotes out. Hnd that just to make me happy, it would remind me childhood Before we had lawns, we pulled thousands of this Hen, removed all the rocks, then loads of soil in a truck were brought in and finally we could lay our 30 pellets of soids While we were at it, we put a second sceptic field in Just in case of a future emergency Our lawns were nice, healthy and green. Green drop came every year to control our weeds. 13 ut our boughest job came, when we had to build a split rail fence around the four acres. We found it to expensive to contract it out. So we gave it atry. After supper every night we put in 3 sections at the time I was the grunter" Michael the pole digger" Truly a lot of work, but we got it done Andwe were proudofit, as we did it ourselves. Just the two of us _ michael and J We drove an hour to a place, where with a special permit we could dig our own trees, ten at a time. We planted and waitered till late at night Today those 12301 biny one footers are now huge They make good shelter in winter when "ourdeer"

come through.

What does this all have to do with another gravel pit you asked?

Well what Jjust mentioned.

Was all this work for nothing?

Isitacrime to have your place look nice and caredfor?

Does that mean anything at all? Probably not to grave compagnies

We don't want another gravel pit anymore

We still would like to have a few more years to enjoy what we worked so hard for and have some peace and quiet.

Have not we suffered enough with all the other pits with their noice, their dust and our sleepless nights?

We can not even open awindow on hot surmer nights.

Is a gravel compagnie really capable of chasing us out of our homes? And destroying our lifes?

This reason is big too

We so enjoy our wildlife. These animals are family to us. We call them our moose our deer. They graze on our property They drink out of our rain barrels

Wegive them names

Every body around here knows, Marvin

She visited us on a snowyday.

Came right on the deck

Snifed our window and said hello howgues?

Can you imagine that?

Itellyou, the secritters are displaced Where once they roomed, gravel pits have taken their place. Please let them be?

ourlungs or our kids.

Itis unfair to poison them with silica dust, never mind my argument

Those critters do not move on as Le High Hanson suggested That is why they land up in our back yard where they feel safe. We want to keep it that way.

Not good neighbors) say. _ not much _ So Laura you have noticed I still am a feisty 86 year old lady I hope I got my feelings across to you. I just had to write all this. From what we understand, the mo of Rocky View has handed , this problem "over to the Province - NRBC-Do we start from scratch! Joont know Laura how much you really knowabout this gravel situation, but my letter to you should give you plenty of information and a good idea why all of us in Bears paw are so tired of fighting for 30 years.
