## Re: Wesley First Nation Amendment to Submitted Written Evidence for Edson Mainline System Expansion Project Hearing

- (1) This letter is submitted on behalf of the Wesley First Nation, one of the three distinct nations of Stoney Nakoda Nations.
- (2) SNN holds Aboriginal rights and title recognized by Treaty No.7 and the *Natural Resources Transfer Act, 1930* and affirmed under Section 35 of the *Constitution Act, 1982.*
- (3) Wesley First Nation is registered as an Intervenor for the Canadian Energy Regulator hearing process on the NOVA Gas Transmission Ltd Edson Mainline Expansion Project.
- (4) Wesley First Nation filed the Wesley First Nation Section 35 Rights Impact Assessment Report (Filing C04028-2) on January 9, 2020 as per directives in CER's Ruling No. 2 -Amended Timetable of Events and List of Issues (Filing C02269-1).
- (5) Wesley First Nation submits two attached map figures as amendments to Figure 4-2.1 and Figure 5-1.1 respectively in the *Wesley First Nation Section 35 Rights Impact Assessment Report.*
- (6) The amended map figures contain the same information as the current Figure 4-2.1 and Figure 5-1.1 of the Wesley First Nation Section 35 Rights Impact Assessment Report, but with further details that support Wesley First Nations filed written evidence.

(7) Given that the amended map figures do not introduce new information but rather add to existing filed evidence, Wesley First Nation requests that the attached map figures replace the current Figure 4-2.1 and Figure 5-1.1 in the *Wesley First Nation Section 35 Rights Impact Assessment Report.*
