Undertaking	To advise why there was a proposal in 2018 regarding adding the segment of Highway 22 between Highway 1 and Highway 8 to the high load corridor network. • If it is determined that the segment of Highway 22 between Highway 1 and Highway 8 has been added to the high load corridor network, to advise when that occurred.
Response	The segment of Highway 22 from Highway 1 to Highway 8 is proposed as future high load corridor in 2017-18. Currently, it is not an in-service high load corridor but could be at any point in the future. As such, Alberta Transportation must consider the requirements of the high load corridor in any decisions made for this portion of the highway.
