Re: Springbank Off-Stream Reservoir Project (the "Project") NRCB Application No. 1701 Calgary River Communities Action Group ("CRCAG") – Final Cost Claim

Please find enclosed CRCAG's application for its final cost claim, in the form prescribed by the Board.

CRCAG is directly affected by the Project and eligible for intervener funding. This was confirmed by the Natural Resources Conservation Board ("**Board**") in its December 10, 2020 Pre-Hearing Conference Decision Report (Exhibit 156, pages 3 and 8). Further details on how CRCAG is directly affected by the Project can be found in CRCAG's pre-hearing conference submissions (Exhibit PHC-13), its written submission (Exhibit 237) and its opening statement (Transcript, Volume 2, pages 418 to 442).

In section 5 of the Board's application form for a final cost claim, it requests information on the intervener voluntary contribution. The voluntary contribution by CRCAG and its members has been considerable. As CRCAG noted in section G of its pre-hearing submissions, in preparation for the submissions and hearing for this application, CRCAG carefully considered which functions required external legal expertise and which functions could be handled by CRCAG and its members.

The CRCAG team, made up of Brenda Leeds Binder, Tony Morris and two other members of CRCAG, organized and drafted the initial drafts of the pre-hearing submissions and evidence (Exhibits 237-241). Moreover, members of CRCAG and other individuals and groups impacted by the 2013 flood contributed to the 218 letters and emails and 393 survey responses included in Appendices B and C of CRCAG's and FFC's evidence (Exhibits 239 and 240). The number of hours which represent these voluntary contributions cannot be accurately estimated but is likely in the hundreds of hours.

We, as external counsel, were only used for those functions that required specialized legal assistance, as further detailed in the summary and legal invoices provided in Schedule "A" of the

enclosed application.

Pursuant to s.28(7) of the Board's Rules of Practice, we have provided a copy of CRCAG's application to counsel for Alberta Transportation.


