



Joint Notice Of Filing Springbank Off-Stream Reservoir Project

Application by Alberta Transportation to Construct an Off-Stream Reservoir Project in Springbank, Alberta

NRCB APPLICATION NO. 1701 AND ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORT

TAKE NOTICE that Alberta Transportation has applied to the Natural Resources Conservation Board (NRCB) and Alberta Environment and Parks for approval to construct an off-stream reservoir project in Springbank. The project is located 15 kilometres west of Calgary, north of the Elbow River.

Non-energy projects that are required by the *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act* (EPEA) to submit an environmental impact assessment report are automatically referred to the NRCB to conduct a public interest review. Approvals for this project are required under the *Natural Resources Conservation Board Act* and the *Water Act*.

Nature of Application

As required by EPEA, Alberta Transportation has prepared and submitted an environmental impact assessment report to Alberta Environment and Parks. This forms part of its application for approval to the NRCB. The NRCB, Alberta Environment and Parks, and other Alberta government departments are reviewing the application. The application is not considered complete until the filed application has been reviewed and any deficiencies supplemented.
