Re: Springbank Off-Stream Reservoir - Review of Environmental Impact Statement ("EIS")

Our firm is legal counsel to John Robinson and Ryan Robinson (together referred to as the "Robinsons") in regards to the proposed Springbank Off-Stream Reservoir Project (the "Project"). The Robinsons own land within the area of the proposed Project.

We write to notify the NRCB that the Robinsons have reached an agreement with the Government of Alberta ("GOA") to sell our lands within the Project area to GOA, which are listed below. We are aware that GOA has not yet filed an application with the NRCB for the Project, nonetheless we are writing to inform the Board that the Robinsons will not be participating in the NRCB process for the Project. Further, the Robinsons are no longer members of the group referred to as "Don't Damn Springbank" and we wish to confirm that neither that group nor their legal counsel are authorized to make any representations on the Robinsons' behalf.
