The permit holder shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that act.

The permit holder shall adhere to the descriptions contained in the filed application RA15060 together with the site plan and other documents attached to that application, unless otherwise noted in the following conditions and as noted in Decision Summary RA15060A.

The permit holder is responsible for all costs associated with monitoring, sampling, testing, recording and reporting requirements.

#### **Operating conditions**

1. **Vegetated Filter Strip**  
The permit holder shall maintain the vegetated filter strip and keep it vegetated at all times with perennial crops. Reseeding of this area shall occur in regular intervals and at such time that the filter strip is not left un-vegetated during spring runoff.
2. **Manure Application**  
The permit holder shall not apply manure on the vegetated filter strip.

This approval becomes effective immediately. The approval conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.

Approval RA15060 is hereby cancelled and is no longer in effect, unless Approval RA15060A is held invalid, in which case the previous permit will remain in effect.

**Existing permitted facilities**

**Construction conditions** (brought forward from Approval RA15060)

1. **Construction completion deadline**  
The permit holder shall complete construction of the feedlot pens prior to September 30, 2017. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.
2. **Post construction inspection**  
The permit holder shall not place livestock or manure in the feedlot pens until the NRCB has inspected the facilities and stated in writing that the facilities have been constructed in accordance with this Approval.
3. **Berm Construction**  
The permit holder shall construct a berm to prevent runoff from entering the creek to the north-east of the feedlot pens. The berm must be large enough to control surface water run-on and runoff from a one day rainfall that has a 1:30 year probability.
