The permit holder shall adhere to the descriptions contained in the filed application for NRCB Approval RA15003, together with the site plan, building plans, and other attached documents.

- Broiler barn (97.5 m x 19.5 m) – already constructed

Miscellaneous Conditions

1. Ferrybank Farming Co. shall not place manure or livestock in the dairy facilities.

This approval becomes effective immediately. The approval conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.

Approval RA15003 is hereby cancelled and is no longer in effect, unless Approval RA15003A is held invalid, in which case the previous permit will remain in effect.

Existing Permitted Facilities

- Hog finishing barn 78.4 m x 20.6 m
- Dry sow / breeding 79.1 m x 14.7 m
- Farrowing / weaning 61.8 m x 13.6 m
- Hog Earthen Manure Storage 119.7 m x 67.3 m
- Little chicken barn (turkey) 28.2 m x 9.6 m
- Big chicken barn 13.5 m x 37.7 m
- Chicken barn/multi-poultry 57 m x 9.4 m

Construction conditions already met for broiler barn #1 (carried forward from Approval RA15003)

1. The concrete used to construct the manure storage and collection system in the chicken poultry barns must have a minimum 28-day strength of 25 MPa. Prior to the inspection referenced in conditions 2 and 3 below, the permit holder shall provide a completion report issued by a third party contractor or a copy of the concrete supplier's invoice to the NRCB to confirm the specifications of the concrete used in the construction.
2. The permit holder shall not allow livestock in broiler barn #1 until the facility has been inspected by NRCB personnel and determined by them, in writing, to have been constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this permit.
3. The permit holder shall complete construction of the manure collection and storage portions of the CFO facilities prior to April 30, 2018. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.
