
In consideration of Decision Summary LA19054, Authorization LA19054 is issued to:

Permitted construction (based on the submitted site plan):

- Manure storage pad extension to total dimensions 45.7 m x 61.0 m (150 ft. x 200 ft.)

The permit holder shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that act.

The permit holder shall adhere to the descriptions contained in the filed application for Authorization LA19054, together with the building plans, engineering reports, and other attached documents. The permit holder shall contact the NRCB at least 10 working days in advance of the desired inspection date to schedule the inspection in conditions #3.

The permit holder is responsible for all costs associated with, sampling, testing, and reporting requirements.

Construction conditions

1. The permit holder shall complete construction of the solid manure storage pad extension prior to November 30, 2022. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.
2. The permit holder shall provide the NRCB with a written construction completion report for the solid manure storage pad extension. The report shall be stamped and signed by a "professional engineer," as defined in the Standards and Administration Regulation, and shall:
 - Certify that the liner material used is the same material that was submitted for hydraulic conductivity testing;
 - Certify the final constructed thickness of the compacted soil liner;
 - Outline the construction procedures and design specification and confirm they are consistent with those provided in the submitted application;
 - Certify that the hydraulic conductivity of the completed manure storage pad is no greater than 5×10^{-7} cm/sec;

This document must be provided to the NRCB prior to the inspection referenced in condition #3 below, or by a later date stated by the NRCB.

3. The permit holder shall not place manure on the extended portion of the manure storage pad until the NRCB has inspected the pad and stated in writing that it has been constructed in accordance with this authorization.

This authorization becomes effective immediately. The authorization conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.
