The permit holder is to adhere to and follow the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that Act.

The permit holder is to adhere to the descriptions contained in Decision Summary LA08024, Decision Summary LA08024A and Approval LA08024 together with the site plan, and other attached documents.

Construction Condition (already constructed at the time of amendment):

- 4 poultry barns (106.6 m x 22.8 m each)

This approval becomes effective immediately. The approval conditions will remain in effect unless amended by the NRCB.

Approval LA08024 is therefore cancelled, unless Approval LA08024A is held invalid following a review and decision by the NRCB's board members or by a court, in which case Approval LA08024 will remain in effect.

Existing facilities:

- 2 rows of feedlot pens (58 m x 74 m and 51 m x 71 m with a total of 4 pens) (deemed permit)

Conditions carried forward from Approval LA08024

1. Completion Reports

A completion report confirming the material and construction procedures for each of the poultry barn floors, prepared by a qualified third party, must be provided to the NRCB prior to animals or manure entering the poultry barns.

2. Construction Completion

Construction of the manure collection and storage portions of the six poultry barns must be completed prior to December 31, 2016 unless otherwise agreed upon by the NRCB.

3. Inspections

The manure storage portion of each of the six poultry barns must be inspected by NRCB personnel prior to animals or manure being placed in the new facilities.
