Permitted (already constructed) facilities:

- Four pens (128.0 m x 54.9 m (420 ft. x 180 ft.) total)
- Expansion of existing pens to the total footprint of: 136 m x 48 m + 45 m x 67 m + 65 m x 42 m)

The permit holder shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that act.

The permit holder shall adhere to the descriptions contained in the filed application together with the site plan, engineering reports and other attached documents and development permit 98-33, unless otherwise noted in the following conditions.

Operating conditions (carried forward from development permit 98-33)

1. Stockpiling of solid manure is not to be done next to roadways and/or water courses, all runoff from stockpiles must be contained in the immediate area of the stockpile."
2. A minimum of 280 irrigated and cultivated acres or 560 dryland acres is to be maintained as an adequate land base for manure utilization
3. The permit holder shall not apply on spreading lands on weekends
4. All manure applied on land must be incorporated within 48 hours of it being applied to the land.

This approval becomes effective immediately. The approval conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.

North Albion's deemed permit and development permit 98-33 are hereby cancelled and are no longer in effect, unless Approval LA20033 is held invalid, in which case the previous permits will remain in effect.

Existing permitted facilities

98-33	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 8 pens – 128 m x 47 m + 38 m x 62 m + 71 m x 43 m • Catch basin – 51 m x 26 m x 5.5 m deep
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Construction conditions (brought forward from 98-33)

- A minimum separation distance of 1580 feet is to be maintained from the expansion/ operation to the nearest neighbouring residence.
- Landscaping of the proposed pen area is to be completed to direct all surface runoff towards a catchment basin or bermed area.
- The size of the catchment area must be approximately 65.000 cubic feet in volume. All soils used in the catchment facility construction must achieve a hydraulic conductivity of 1×10^7 cm/sec.
- Prior to the construction of the catchment facility, the applicant is to obtain the services of an engineer who will provide an engineered plan of the catch basin, soil and hydrology testing and berm design, to the satisfaction of Alberta Agriculture.
