In consideration of Decision Summary LA20042, Authorization LA20042 is issued to:

**Permitted construction** (based on the submitted site plan):

- Duck barn (32 m x 16 m)

The permit holder shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that act.

The permit holder shall adhere to the descriptions contained in the filed application together with the site plan, and other attached documents unless otherwise noted in the following conditions.

The permit holder shall contact the NRCB at least 10 working days in advance of the desired inspection date to schedule the inspection in condition #3.

**Construction conditions**

**Concrete**

1. The permit holder shall provide proof that the concrete used to construct the liner of the duck barn meets the specification for category D (solid manure – dry) in Technical Guideline Agdex 096-93 “Non-Engineered Concrete Liners for Manure Collection and Storage Areas.”

**Construction completion deadline**

2. The permit holder shall complete construction of the duck barn prior to December 31, 2023. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.

**Post construction inspections**

3. The permit holder shall not place livestock or manure in the duck barn until the NRCB has inspected the facility and stated in writing that the facility has been constructed in accordance with this authorization.

**Decommissioning of existing duck barn**

4. The existing duck barn shall be decommissioned using Technical Guideline Agdex 096-90 Closure of Manure Storage Facilities – for facilities with solid manure posing a low risk to the environment.



This authorization becomes effective immediately and has to be read in conjunction with previously issued Approval LA20031. The authorization conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.
