**Permitted construction** (based on the submitted site plan):

- Extension to barn #2 by 8.5 m x 19.5 m (28 ft. x 64 ft.) to a total of 29.3 m x 19.5 m (96 ft. x 64 ft.)

The permit holder is also permitted to use barns 1 (20.1 m x 12.2 m), 2 (20.7 m x 19.5 m), 3 (19.2 m x 10.4 m), and 4 (16 m x 13 m) to house chicken layers (plus associated pullets).

The permit holder shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that act.

The permit holder shall adhere to the descriptions contained in the filed application LA20046 together with the site plan, and other attached, unless otherwise noted in the following conditions.

The permit holder shall contact the NRCB at least 10 working days in advance of the desired inspection date to schedule the inspection in condition #4.

The permit holder is responsible for all costs associated with monitoring, sampling, testing, recording and reporting requirements.

**Construction conditions**

**Concrete**

1. The concrete used to construct the barn extension of barn 2 must have a minimum 28-day strength of 25 MPa. The permit holder shall provide proof to the NRCB to confirm the specifications of the concrete used in the construction. This document must be provided to the NRCB prior to the inspection referenced in condition #4 below or by a later date stated by the NRCB.

**Construction above the water table**

2. The permit holder is to cease construction and to immediately notify the NRCB if the water table is encountered during construction.

**Construction completion deadline**

3. The permit holder shall complete construction of the poultry barn #2 extension prior to April 1, 2022. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.

**Post construction inspection**

4. The permit holder shall not place livestock or manure in the new poultry barn #2 extension until the NRCB has inspected the facilities and stated in writing that the facilities have been constructed in accordance with this registration.

**Water well monitoring (sampling, testing and reporting)**

5. The permit holder shall sample and test raw groundwater from water well #291327 (located east of the new poultry barn #2 extension ) according to water well monitoring requirements prescribed by the NRCB in writing. The NRCB may, based on the monitoring results and at its discretion, revise those requirements from time to time, in writing.

This registration becomes effective immediately. The registration conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.
