

Notice of Status Determination Confined Feeding Operation

Anchor Y Cattle Co. Ltd. (Allan Thorpe) has requested the Natural Resources Conservation Board (NRCB) to complete a grandfathering determination for their confined feeding operation (CFO). The CFO is located on the NE 23-34-3 W5M in Red Deer County of Alberta. The NRCB will determine the grandfathered livestock capacity and type of the CFO as it existed on January 1, 2002.

The NRCB invites you to provide input on the grandfathered livestock status of this operation, its livestock capacity and type, and facilities as they existed on January 1, 2002. Anchor Y Cattle Co. Ltd. (Allan Thorpe) has stated that its grandfathered livestock capacity and type is 2000 beef finishers. This notice is provided to invite input on the grandfathering determination of livestock number.

Filing a Statement

Any person who has knowledge about the size and status of the CFO on or around January 1, 2002 is invited to submit a statement with this information to the NRCB. The statement must be received by the NRCB on or before April 19, 2021. Submissions should be made to the NRCB address provided below. A copy of the statement will be sent to the applicant. Statements are also considered public records and are non-confidential.

Your statement should include your name, the legal land description of your residence or landholdings, mailing address, phone number, email address, and details about your knowledge of the operation as it relates to the facilities, livestock type, and livestock capacity of the CFO on or around January 1, 2002. You may also file an application for directly affected party status at this time.

Viewing the Application

A complete copy of the information filed by the applicant under the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* may be viewed **only** on the NRCB website at www.nrcb.ca (under Confined Feeding Operations / Applications & Decisions / Notice of Applications) until April 19, 2021. Until further notice, the information will **not** be available for in-person viewing as the Red Deer office of the NRCB is closed to the public due to COVID-19.
