Permitted construction (based on the submitted site plan):

- 2 chicken breeder barns (each 92.7 m x 30.0 m)

The co-permit holders shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that act.

The co-permit holders shall adhere to the descriptions contained in the filed applications RA18036 and RA21006, together with the site plan, building plans, and other attached documents, unless otherwise noted in the following conditions.

The co-permit holders shall contact the NRCB at least 10 working days in advance of the desired inspection date to schedule the inspection in conditions #2 and 5.

Construction conditions

Chicken Breeder Barn (North)

1. The co-permit holders shall construct the concrete liner of the manure storage and collection system in the chicken breeder barn (north) to meet the specifications for category D (solid manure-dry) in Technical Guideline Agdex 096-96 “Non-Engineered Concrete Liners for Manure Collection and Storage Areas.” The co-permit holders shall provide documentation that the concrete used for the manure collection and storage areas meets the required specifications. This document must be provided to the NRCB prior to the inspection referenced in condition #2 below, or by a later date specified by the NRCB.
2. The co-permit holders shall not allow livestock or manure in the new chicken breeder barn (north) until the barn has been inspected by NRCB personnel and confirmed by them, in writing, to have been constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this permit.
3. The co-permit holders shall complete construction of the new chicken breeder barn (north) prior to December 1, 2022. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.



Chicken Breeder Barn (South)

4. The co-permit holders shall construct the concrete liner of the manure storage and collection system in the chicken breeder barn (south) to meet the specifications for category D (solid manure-dry) in Technical Guideline Agdex 096-96 "Non-Engineered Concrete Liners for Manure Collection and Storage Areas." The co-permit holders shall provide documentation that the concrete used for the manure collection and storage areas meets the required specifications. This document must be provided to the NRCB prior to the inspection referenced in condition #5 below, or by a later date specified by the NRCB.
5. The co-permit holders shall not allow livestock or manure in the new chicken breeder barn (south) until the barn has been inspected by NRCB personnel and confirmed by them, in writing, to have been constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this permit.
6. The co-permit holders shall complete construction of the new chicken breeder barn (south) prior to December 1, 2022. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.

This Approval becomes effective immediately. The Approval conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.

Approval RA18036 is hereby cancelled and is no longer in effect, unless Approval RA21006 is held invalid, in which case the previous permit will remain in effect.

Existing permitted facilities

Chicken Broiler Barn 1 (160.4 m x 21.2 m)	RA18036

Completed construction conditions (brought forward from RA18036)

Broiler chicken barns (note, only two of the permitted four barns were constructed. The permitted chicken broiler numbers have been reduced to reflect this change. The two permitted broiler barns are shown in the site plan for RA21006)

1. The permit holder shall construct the concrete liner of the manure storage and collection system in the broiler chicken barns to meet the specifications for category D (solid manure-dry) in Technical Guideline Agdex 096-93 “Non-Engineered Concrete Liners for Manure Collection and Storage Areas.” The permit holder shall provide documentation that the concrete used for the manure collection and storage areas meets the required specifications. This document must be provided to the NRCB prior to the inspection referenced in condition #2 below or by a later date stated by the NRCB.
2. The permit holder shall not allow livestock or manure in the new broiler barns until the barns have been inspected by NRCB personnel and confirmed by them, in writing, to have been constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this permit.
3. The permit holder shall complete construction of the new broiler chicken barns prior to November 30, 2021. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.
