



In consideration of Decision Summary LA20048, Authorization LA20048 is issued to:

Name: Happy Acres Farms Ltd. (the "permit holder")

Permitted construction (based on the submitted site plan):

- New pen attached to existing pens – 62 m x 41.5 m
- New catch basin – 35 m x 17 m x 2.5 m

The permit holder shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that act.

The permit holder shall adhere to the descriptions contained in the filed application together with the site plan, operating plan, engineering reports and other attached documents, unless otherwise noted in the following conditions.

The permit holder shall contact the NRCB at least 10 working days in advance of the desired inspection date to schedule the inspection in conditions #3 and 5.

The permit holder is responsible for all costs associated with monitoring, sampling, testing, recording and reporting requirements.

Construction conditions

1. Decommissioning of existing pen
 - a. Within one year of the completion of construction of the new pen, the permit holder shall decommission the existing pen as identified in TD LA20048 in accordance with Technical Guideline Agdex 096-90, "Closure of Manure Storage Facilities and Manure Collection Areas."

New pen attached to existing pens

2. The permit holder shall complete construction of the new pen attached to existing pens prior to December 15, 2023. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.
3. The permit holder shall not allow livestock or manure in the new pen until NRCB personnel have inspected the facility and confirmed, in writing, that it has been constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this permit.



New catch basin

4. The permit holder shall complete construction of the manure collection and storage portions of the new catch basin prior to December 15, 2023. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.
5. The permit holder shall not allow manure contaminated runoff to enter the new catch basin until the NRCB has inspected the catch basin and stated in writing that it has been constructed in accordance with this authorization.

This authorization becomes effective immediately. The authorization conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB. This authorization must be read in conjunction with the permit holder's deemed approval, which remains in effect.
