



In consideration of Decision Summary LA21019, Authorization LA21019 is issued to:

Permitted construction (based on the submitted site plan):

- Manure transfer pit – 1.2 m x 1.8 m x 4.5 m

The permit holder shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that act.

The permit holder shall adhere to the descriptions contained in the filed application together with the site plan and, building plans, unless otherwise noted in the following conditions.

The permit holder shall contact the NRCB at least 10 working days in advance of the desired inspection date to schedule the inspection in conditions #3.

The permit holder is responsible for all costs associated with sampling, recording, and reporting requirements.

Construction conditions (Manure transfer pit)

1. The permit holder shall complete the construction of the manure transfer pit prior to December 29, 2022. Upon written request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.
2. The concrete used to construct the manure transfer pit must be sulphate resistant and have a minimum 56-day compressive strength of 32 MPa.

The permit holder shall provide written documentation to the NRCB confirming the specifications of the concrete used in the construction of the manure transfer pit. This documentation must be provided to the NRCB prior to the inspection referenced in condition #3, or by a later date stated in writing by the NRCB.

3. The permit holder shall not place manure in the transfer pit until NRCB personnel have inspected the pit and stated in writing that it has been constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this approval.

This authorization becomes effective immediately in conjunction with the deemed registration (including municipal permits 99-62 and 97-171) which exists for the site. The authorization conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.
