



In consideration of Decision Summary RA21022, Authorization RA21022 is issued to:

Name: Edwin & Sandra Spruit, and Spruit Farms Ltd. (the “co-permit holders”)

Permitted construction (based on the submitted site plan):

- Renovation to “old west” barn (26 m x 6.4 m)

The co-permit holders shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that act.

The co-permit holders shall adhere to the descriptions contained in the filed application, together with the site plan and other attached documents, unless otherwise noted in the following conditions.

The co-permit holders shall contact the NRCB at least 10 working days in advance of the desired inspection date to schedule the inspection in condition four.

The co-permit holders are responsible for all costs associated with monitoring, sampling, testing, recording and reporting requirements.

Construction conditions

1. Construction above water table
The co-permit holders shall immediately cease renovation to the manure collection and storage liner in the “old west” barn, and contact the NRCB immediately, if the water table is observed to be one metre or less from the bottom of the barn renovation during construction.
2. Construction completion deadline
The co-permit holders shall complete the renovation to the manure collection and storage liner of the “old west” barn prior to November 30, 2022. Upon written request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.
3. Concrete
The concrete used to renovate the manure collection and storage liner of the “old west” barn must meet the requirements of Category B in Technical Guideline Agdex 096-93 “Non-Engineered Concrete Liners for Manure Collection and Storage Areas.”

The co-permit holders shall provide documentation to the NRCB confirming the specifications of the concrete used in the renovation of the manure collection and storage liner of the “old west” barn. This documentation must be provided to the NRCB prior to the inspection referenced in condition four, or by a later date stated in writing by the NRCB.



4. Post construction inspection

The co-permit holders shall not place manure or livestock in the renovated portion of the “old west” barn until NRCB personnel have inspected it and stated in writing that it has been renovated in accordance with the terms and conditions of this authorization.

This authorization becomes effective immediately and needs to be read in conjunction with Approval RA14007, as amended by RA14007B, and Authorization RA16036. This authorization’s conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.
