



In consideration of Decision Summary RA21005A and RA21005, Authorization RA21005A is issued to:

Permitted construction (based on the submitted site plan):

- Sand separation building (61 m x 18.3 m x 3.6 m deep)

The co-permit holders shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that act.

The co-permit holders shall adhere to the descriptions contained in the filed application RA21005 and the replaced pages in RA21005A, together with the site plan, building plans, and other attached documents, unless otherwise noted in the following conditions.

The co-permit holders shall contact the NRCB at least 10 working days in advance of the desired inspection date to schedule the inspection in conditions #3.

The co-permit holders are responsible for all costs associated with reporting requirements.

Construction conditions

1. The co-permit holders shall immediately cease construction of the new sand separation building and contact the NRCB if the water table is observed to be one metre or less from the bottom of the new sand separation building’s liner at the time of construction.
2. The concrete used to construct the liner of the sand separation building must meet the specifications for category B (liquid manure-shallow pits) in Technical Guideline Agdex 096-93 “Non-Engineered Concrete Liners for Manure Collection and Storage Areas”. The co-permit holders shall provide written confirmation, from a qualified third party, confirming that the concrete used for the manure collection and storage areas meet the required specifications.
3. The co-permit holders shall not allow manure in the new sand separation building until the facility has been inspected by NRCB personnel and confirmed by them, in writing, to have been constructed with the terms and conditions of this permit.
4. The co-permit holders shall complete construction of the manure collection and storage portions of the sand separation building prior to December 31, 2022. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.



This Authorization becomes effective immediately, and must be read in conjunction with previously issued Approval RA19060. Authorization RA21005 is therefore cancelled, unless Authorization RA21005A is held invalid following a review and decision by the NRCB's board members or by a court, which in case Authorization RA21005 will remain in effect. The authorization conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.
