**Permitted construction** (based on the submitted site plan):

- Young stock facility with straw packs and scrape alleys  
(17.4 m x 25.9 m and 15.9 m x 13.7 m)

The co-permit holders shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that act.

The co-permit holders shall adhere to the descriptions contained in the filed application together with the site plan, building plans and other attached documents, unless otherwise noted in the following conditions.

The co-permit holders shall contact the NRCB at least 10 working days in advance of the desired inspection date to schedule the inspection in condition three.

The co-permit holders are responsible for all costs associated with monitoring, sampling, testing, recording and reporting requirements.

### **Construction conditions**

1. Construction completion deadline  
The co-permit holders shall complete construction of the straw packs and scrape alleys prior to October 31, 2022. Upon written request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.

2. Concrete  
The concrete used to construct the straw packs and the scrape alleys must meet the requirements of Category D and C, respectively, in Technical Guideline Agdex 096-93 “Non-Engineered Concrete Liners for Manure Collection and Storage Areas.”

The co-permit holders shall provide documentation to the NRCB confirming the specifications of the concrete used in the straw packs and scrape alleys. This documentation must be provided to the NRCB prior to the inspection referenced in condition three, or by a later date stated in writing by the NRCB.

3. Post construction inspection  
The co-permit holders shall not place manure or livestock in the straw packs or scrape alleys until NRCB personnel have inspected them and stated in writing that they have been constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this authorization.



This authorization becomes effective immediately and needs to be read in conjunction with registrations RA06014 and RA06014A. The authorization conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.
