Permitted construction (based on the submitted site plan):

- poultry barn (78.5 m x 16.2 m)
- manure storage attached to poultry barn (18.3 m x 14.9 m)

The co-permit holders shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that act.

The co-permit holders shall adhere to the descriptions contained in the filed application together with the site plan, building plan and other attached documents unless otherwise noted in the following conditions.

The co-permit holders shall contact the NRCB at least 10 working days in advance of the desired inspection date to schedule the inspection in condition three.

The co-permit holders are responsible for all costs associated with monitoring, sampling, testing, recording and reporting requirements.

Construction conditions

1. Construction completion deadline

The co-permit holders shall complete construction of the poultry barn and its attached manure storage prior to November 29, 2024. Upon written request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.

2. Concrete

The concrete used to construct the liner or floor of the poultry barn and the manure storage must meet the requirements of Category D in Technical Guideline Agdex 096-93 "Non-Engineered Concrete Liners for Manure Collection and Storage Areas."

The co-permit holders shall provide evidence from a qualified third party to the NRCB confirming the specifications of the concrete used in the poultry barn and manure storage. This documentation must be provided to the NRCB prior to the inspection referenced in condition three, or by a later date stated in writing by the NRCB.



3. Post construction inspection

The co-permit holders shall not place manure or livestock in the poultry barn or the manure storage until NRCB personnel have inspected them and stated in writing that they have been constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this authorization.

This registration becomes effective immediately, and its conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.
