Permitted construction (based on the submitted site plan):

- Poultry barn (converted from the beef calf barn) (84 m x 24 m)

Ancillary facilities:

- Addition to the equipment room of 12.2 m x 11.3 m (for a total of 24.4 m x 22.6 m)

The permit holder shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that act.

The permit holder shall adhere to the descriptions contained in the filed application RA20037 and RA22004 together with the site plan, building plans, operating plan and other attached documents, unless otherwise noted in the following conditions.

The permit holder shall contact the NRCB at least 10 working days in advance of the desired inspection date to schedule the inspection in condition #2

Construction conditions

1. The concrete used to construct the liner of the poultry barn (converted from the beef calf barn) must meet the specifications for category D (solid manure – dry), in Technical Guideline Agdex 096-93 "Non-Engineered Concrete Liners for Manure Collection and Storage Areas." The permit holder shall provide documentation to confirm the specifications of the concrete used for the manure collection and storage areas meets the required specification.
2. The permit holder shall not allow birds or place manure in the poultry barn (converted from the beef calf barn), until the facility has been inspected by NRCB personnel and confirmed by them, in writing, to have been constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this permit.
3. The permit holder shall complete construction of the manure collection and storage portions of the poultry barn (converted from the beef calf barn) prior to November 30, 2023. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.

This registration becomes effective immediately. The registration conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.



Registration RA20037 is hereby cancelled and is no longer in effect, unless Registration RA22004 is held invalid, in which case the previous permit will remain in effect.

Construction conditions

Registration RA14031

- The permit holder shall complete construction of the manure collection and storage portions of the west sheep corral prior to November 30, 2017. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.
- The permit holder shall not place livestock in the west sheep corral until the NRCB has inspected the facility and stated in writing that the facility has been constructed in accordance with this permit.

Registration RA09030

- Construction of the sheep barn and corrals and the old dairy barn into an orphan lamb barn must be completed prior to March 31, 2011, unless otherwise agreed upon by the NRCB.
- The new sheep barn and corrals and the orphan lamb barn must be inspected by NRCB personnel prior to animals or manure being placed in the new sheep barn and corrals.
- If the 1927 water well is located, the NRCB must be informed of its location and any abandonment, unless the operator is notified in writing by the NRCB.
