

Notice of Status Determination Confined Feeding Operation

City Packers Feedlot (2003) Ltd. has requested the Natural Resources Conservation Board (NRCB) to complete a grandfathering determination for their confined feeding operation (CFO). The CFO is located on the NE 32-9-21 W4M in the Lethbridge County of Alberta. The NRCB will determine the grandfathered livestock capacity and type of the CFO as it existed on January 1, 2002. There was recently another notice of grandfathering determination at this site. This is a new notice because it is a revised claim.

By this notice the NRCB invites you to provide input on the grandfathered livestock status of this operation, its livestock capacity and type, and facilities as they existed on January 1, 2002. City Packers Feedlot (2003) Ltd. has stated that its grandfathered capacity is 7,500 beef finishers.

Filing a Statement

Any person who has knowledge about the size and status of the CFO on or around January 1, 2002 is invited to submit a statement with this information to the NRCB. The statement must be received by the NRCB on or before November 3, 2021. Submissions should be made to the NRCB address provided below. Statements are considered public records and are non-confidential.

Your statement should include your name, the legal land description of your residence or landholdings, mailing address, phone number, email address, and details about your knowledge of the operation as it relates to the facilities, livestock type, and livestock capacity of the CFO on or around January 1, 2002. You may also file an application for directly affected party status at this time.

Viewing the Application

A copy of the request for the grandfathering determination and the public notice may be viewed **only** on the NRCB website at www.nrcb.ca (under Confined Feeding Operations / Applications & Decisions / Notice of Applications) until November 3, 2021. Until further notice, they will **not** be available for in-person viewing as the Lethbridge office of the NRCB is closed to the public due to COVID-19.
