

Notice of Status Determination Confined Feeding Operation

John Liefing has requested the Natural Resources Conservation Board (NRCB) complete a grandfathering determination for his confined feeding operation (CFO). The CFO is located on the NW 7-11-20 W4M in the Lethbridge County of Alberta. The NRCB will determine the grandfathered status of the CFO's outside pens (i.e., the facilities footprint, livestock type, and livestock capacity of the outside pens as they existed on January 1, 2002).

The NRCB invites you to provide input on the grandfathered status of this operation's outside pens including: the pens livestock capacity, livestock type and the facilities footprint as they existed on January 1, 2002. John Liefing has stated that its grandfathered livestock capacity of the outside pens is 400 beef finishers (900+ lbs) This notice is provided to invite input on the grandfathering determination.

Filing a Statement

Any person who has knowledge about the size and status of the CFO's outside pens on or around January 1, 2002 is invited to submit a statement with this information to the NRCB. The statement must be received by the NRCB on or before February 15, 2022. Submissions can be made to the NRCB email address provided below. A copy of the statement may be sent to the applicant. Statements are also considered public records and are non-confidential.

Your statement should include your name, the legal land description of your residence or landholdings, mailing address, phone number, email address, and details about your knowledge of the operation as it relates to the outside pens including: livestock type, facilities footprint, and livestock capacity of the outside pens on or around January 1, 2002. You may also file an application for directly affected party status at this time.

Until further notice, the request will **not** be available for in-person viewing as the Lethbridge office of the NRCB is closed to the public due to COVID-19.
