

# Notice of Status Determination Confined Feeding Operation

Abt Cattle Co. Ltd. has requested the Natural Resources Conservation Board (NRCB) to complete a grandfathering determination for their confined feeding operation (CFO). The livestock operation is located on the SE 18-44-25 W4M in Ponoka County, Alberta. The NRCB's review of the application requires the NRCB to determine the grandfathered status of the livestock operation (i.e., the facilities, livestock type, and livestock capacity of the operation as it existed on January 1, 2002).

**The NRCB invites you to provide input on the grandfathered status of this operation, its livestock capacity, livestock type, and facilities as they existed on January 1, 2002.** Abt Cattle Co. Ltd. has stated that its grandfathered livestock capacity and type is 2,000 beef feeders. This notice is provided to invite input on the grandfathering determination.

## Filing a Statement

Any person who has knowledge about the size and status of the livestock operation on or around January 1, 2002 is invited to submit a statement with this information to the NRCB. The statement must be received by the NRCB on or before 4:30 pm on July 28, 2022. Submissions should be made to the email address provided below. A copy of the statement will be sent to the applicant. Statements submitted regarding the application may be posted on the NRCB's public website, as they are public records and are non-confidential.

Your statement should include your name, the legal land description of your residence or landholdings, mailing address, email address, phone number, and details about your knowledge of the operation as it relates to the facilities, livestock type, and livestock capacity of the operation on or around January 1, 2002. You may also file an application for directly affected party status at this time.
