



**Total permitted animal capacity from all permits for this site:**

**Permitted construction** (based on the submitted site plan):

- Chicken layer barn – 118 m x 26 m with attached manure storage area 15 m x 10 m
- Chicken pullet barn – 63 m x 13.5 m with attached manure storage area 19 m x 10 m

The permit holder shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that act.

The permit holder shall adhere to the descriptions contained in the filed application LA21054 together with the site plan, building plans, and other attached documents, unless otherwise noted in the following conditions.

The permit holder shall contact the NRCB at least 10 working days in advance of the desired inspection date to schedule the inspection in conditions #3 and 7.

The permit holder is responsible for all costs associated with monitoring, sampling, testing, recording and reporting requirements.

**Construction conditions**

Chicken Layer Barn with attached solid manure storage area

1. The permit holder shall immediately cease construction of the chicken layer barn and attached solid manure storage area, and contact the NRCB if the water table is observed to be one metre or less from the bottom of the liner of the manure collection and storage areas.
2. The concrete used to construct the liner of the chicken layer barn and attached solid manure storage area must meet the specifications for category D (solid manure-dry) in Technical Guideline Agdex 096-93 “Non-Engineered Concrete Liners for Manure Collection and Storage Areas”. The permit holder shall provide written documentation, confirming that the concrete used for the manure collection and storage areas meet the required specifications.
3. The permit holder shall not allow livestock or manure in the chicken layer barn, or manure in the solid manure storage area, until the facilities have been inspected by NRCB personnel and confirmed by them, in writing, to have been constructed according to the terms and conditions of this permit.



4. The permit holder shall complete construction of the manure collection and storage portions of the chicken layer barn and solid manure storage area prior to November 30, 2024. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.

Chicken Pullet Barn with attached solid manure storage area

5. The permit holder shall immediately cease construction of the chicken pullet barn and attached solid manure storage area, and contact the NRCB if the water table is observed to be one metre or less from the bottom of the liner of the manure collection and storage areas.
6. The concrete used to construct the liner of the chicken pullet barn and attached solid manure storage area must meet the specifications for category D (solid manure-dry) in Technical Guideline Agdex 096-93 "Non-Engineered Concrete Liners for Manure Collection and Storage Areas". The permit holder shall provide written documentation, confirming that the concrete used for the manure collection and storage areas meet the required specifications.
7. The permit holder shall not allow livestock or manure in the chicken pullet barn, or manure in the solid manure storage area, until the facilities have been inspected by NRCB personnel and confirmed by them, in writing, to have been constructed with the terms and conditions of this permit.
8. The permit holder shall complete construction of the manure collection and storage portions of the chicken pullet barn and solid manure storage area prior to November 30, 2024. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.

**Operating conditions**

9. The permit holder shall immediately notify the NRCB if springs are observed to be 100 metre or less from any manure collection facilities or manure storage areas.
10. The permit holder is required to submit a copy of their completed drillers report, done by a qualified third party, to the NRCB if a water well is developed on the site. The report must be submitted directly to the NRCB within a month of the water well being completed.

This registration becomes effective immediately. The registration conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.
