



In consideration of Decision Summary RA22017, Authorization RA22017 is issued to:

Permitted construction (based on the submitted site plan):

- Calving, maternity, and youngstock barn addition 27.9 m x 18.9 m
(final barn dimensions to be 27.9 m x 33.9 m, 21.1 m x 15 m and 24.4 m x 21 m)

The permit holder shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that act.

The permit holder shall adhere to the descriptions contained in the filed application RA22017 together with the site plan, building plan and other attached documents, unless otherwise noted in the following conditions.

The permit holder shall contact the NRCB at least 10 working days in advance of the desired inspection date to schedule the inspection in condition three.

The permit holder is responsible for all costs associated with monitoring, sampling, testing, recording and reporting requirements.

Construction conditions

1. Construction completion deadline

The permit holder shall complete construction of the barn addition prior to October 31, 2023. Upon written request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.

2. Concrete

The concrete used to construct the liner of the barn addition must meet the requirements of category D (solid manure – dry) in Technical Guideline Agdex 096-93 "Non-Engineered Concrete Liners for Manure Collection and Storage Areas."

3. Post construction inspection

The permit holder shall not place manure or livestock in the barn addition until NRCB personnel have inspected it and stated in writing that it has been constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this authorization.

Operating conditions

4. Water well testing

Water quality tests shall be conducted on the "residential" water well (as identified on page six of Technical Document RA22017) in accordance with the Water Well Monitoring Requirements statement, dated 11 July 22, as amended.



5. Water well usage

The permit holder shall not use the “residential” water well for domestic purposes.

This authorization becomes effective immediately and needs to be read in conjunction with the deemed registration, Registration RA12014 and Authorization RA16037. The authorization conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.
