**Permitted construction** (based on the submitted site plan):

- North runoff control catch basin (50 m x 40 m x 2.2 m deep)
- South runoff control catch basin (60 m x 40 m x 2.2 m deep)

**Permit already constructed facilities** (based on the submitted site plan):

- Pen 205 – 67 m x 62 m
- Pen 208 – 75 m x 72 m
- Pen 301 – 78 m x 66 m
- Pen 303 – 85 m x 66 m
- Pen 305 – 79 m x 71 m

The permit holder shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that act.

The permit holder shall adhere to the descriptions contained in the filed application together with the site plan, building plans, engineering reports and other attached documents, unless otherwise noted in the following conditions.

The permit holder shall contact the NRCB at least 10 working days in advance of the desired inspection date to schedule the inspection in conditions # 1 and 3.

The permit holder is responsible for all costs associated with monitoring, sampling, testing, recording and reporting requirements.

**Construction conditions**

**North catch basin**

1. The permit holder shall not allow manure impacted runoff in the north runoff control catch basin, until the facility has been inspected by NRCB personnel and confirmed by them, in writing, to have been constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this permit.
2. The permit holder shall complete construction of the manure collection and storage portions of the north runoff control catch basin prior to November 30, 2023. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.



South catch basin

3. The permit holder shall not allow manure impacted runoff in the south runoff control catch basin, until the facility has been inspected by NRCB personnel and confirmed by them, in writing, to have been constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this permit.
4. The permit holder shall complete construction of the manure collection and storage portions of the south runoff control catch basin prior to November 30, 2023. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.

**Operating condition**

5. The permit holder shall sample and test raw groundwater from water well #153357, according to water well monitoring requirements prescribed by the NRCB in writing. The NRCB may, based on the monitoring results and at its discretion, revise those requirements from time to time, in writing.

This approval becomes effective immediately. The approval conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.

Goodbrand's deemed approval is hereby superseded and is no longer in effect, unless Approval RA22015 is held invalid, in which case the previous permit will remain in effect.
