The permit holder shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that act.

The permit holder shall adhere to the descriptions contained in the filed Application LA22009 and development permits 92-83 and 97-105 together with the site plan and other attached documents, unless otherwise noted in the following conditions.

Operating conditions carried over from development permit 97-105

1. All manure shall be incorporated immediately after spreading.
2. No spreading is to occur on frozen or now covered fields or on weekends.
3. A fly control program is to be maintained.

This approval becomes effective immediately. The approval conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.

Green Life’s deemed permits, including development permits #92-83 and #97-105, are hereby superseded, and their content consolidated into this Approval LA22009, unless Approval LA22009 is held invalid following a review and decision by the NRCB’s board members or by a court, in which case development permits# 92-83 and #97-105 will remain in effect.

Approval LA22009 – Appendix

Existing permitted facilities

Feedlot pens (marked in red in Technical Document LA22009): 113 m x 153 m and 69 m x 88 m + 91 m x 94 m

Construction conditions (brought forward from MDP 92-83)

- 1) The expansion is to be located as per submitted sketch and will bring the total number of animals to 4,500 head.
- 2) Control of runoff to prevent seepage into drainage canal and Oldman River.

Construction conditions (brought forward from MDP 97-105)

- 1) A soil test/drilling analysis must be conducted in the area of the catchment facilities with results to be submitted prior to any construction
- 2) Catchment basins are to be engineer designed for the existing and proposed expansion to a capacity and location approved by Albert Agriculture
- 3) The applicant must demonstrate that any potential runoff from the feedlot, stockpiling or spreading of manure will not enter the Battersea Drain or the Oldman River Valley.
