

# Notice of Application

## Confined Feeding Operation

Darcor Holsteins Inc. (Damien Rasmuson) has filed application RA22027 with the Natural Resources Conservation Board (NRCB) to obtain a registration to convert livestock category on a confined feeding operation (CFO) located at the NE 14-47-23 W4M in the County of Wetaskiwin of Alberta. The application is to convert the existing hog operation and expand it into a dairy CFO with 190 milking cows (plus associated dries and replacements). The application proposes to decommission or convert all existing hog buildings and to construct a dairy barn, a calf barn, and a synthetically lined liquid manure storage.

### Filing a Statement

Any person who is directly affected by the application may submit a statement of concern to the NRCB. The statement of concern must be received by the NRCB on or before 4:30 pm on February 9, 2023. Submissions should be made to the NRCB address provided below. A copy of the statement of concern will be sent to the applicant for review and comment. Statements submitted regarding the application may be posted on the NRCB's public website, as they are public records and are non-confidential.

Your statement of concern should include your name, the legal land description of your residence or landholdings, mailing address, phone number, and a detailed summary that describes how you would be directly affected by this application. You may also file an application for directly affected party status at this time.

Failure to submit a statement of concern may affect your rights to apply for an NRCB review.
