The co-permit holders shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that act.

The co-permit holders shall adhere to the descriptions contained in the filed application, together with the site plan, building plans, engineering report, and other attached documents, unless otherwise noted in the following conditions.

The co-permit holders shall contact the NRCB at least 10 working days in advance of the desired inspection date to schedule the inspection in conditions 1 & 4.

The co-permit holders are responsible for all costs associated with recording and reporting requirements.



Construction conditions

Feedlot pens

1. The co-permit holders shall not place livestock or manure in the new feedlot pens until the facilities have been inspected by NRCB personnel and confirmed by them, in writing, to have been constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this permit.
2. The co-permit holders shall complete construction of the new feedlot pens prior to November 30, 2025. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.

Catch basin

3. The co-permit holders shall provide the NRCB with written confirmation from a qualified third party that provides confirmation of the catch basin's constructed dimensions, including side slopes.
4. The co-permit holders shall not allow manure impacted runoff to enter the catch basin until the facility has been inspected by NRCB personnel and confirmed by them, in writing, to have been constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this permit.
5. The co-permit holders shall complete construction of the catch basin prior to November 30, 2025. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.

This approval becomes effective immediately. The approval conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.
