



In consideration of Decision Summary RA22031, Authorization RA22031 is issued to:

Permitted construction (based on the submitted site plan):

- Dairy barn – 40 m x 58 m

Ancillary structure

- Milk house – 12 m x 15 m and pump house – 6 m x 4 m

The co-permit holders shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that act.

The co-permit holders shall adhere to the descriptions contained in the filed applications RA22031, and RA06015, together with the site plan, building plans, and other attached documents, unless otherwise noted in the following conditions.

The co-permit holders shall contact the NRCB at least 10 working days in advance of the desired inspection date to schedule the inspection in condition #3.

The co-permit holders are responsible for all costs associated with testing, recording and reporting requirements.

Construction conditions

Dairy barn

1. The co-permit holders shall complete construction of the manure collection and storage portions of the dairy barn prior to June 30, 2025. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing
2. The concrete used to construct the liner of the dairy barn must meet the specifications for category B (liquid manure shallow pits), and category C (solid manure-wet), in Technical Guideline Agdex 096-93 “Non-Engineered Concrete Liners for Manure Collection and Storage Areas.” The co-permit holders shall provide written confirmation confirming that the concrete used for the manure collection and storage areas meets the required specifications.
3. The co-permit holders shall not allow livestock or manure in the dairy barn, until the facility has been inspected by NRCB personnel and confirmed by them, in writing, to have been constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this permit.



4. The co-permit holders shall decommission the existing calf barn and part of the heifer pen, in accordance with Technical Guideline Agdex 096-90, "Closure of Manure Storage Facilities and Manure Collection Areas". This shall be completed within 1 year of the construction completion of the new dairy barn. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.

This authorization becomes effective immediately and needs to be read in conjunction with previously issued Authorization RA06015 and the deemed registration. The authorization conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.
