



In consideration of Decision Summary RA24007, Authorization RA24007 is issued to:

Name: Theodorus (Theo) and Johanna Broekman operating as Broekman Hog Farms Ltd. (the “co-permit holders”)
Address: RR 1 Site 7 Box 16 Olds, AB T4H 1P2

Permitted construction (based on the submitted site plan):

- Hog finisher barn – 35.4 m x 25.8 m
- Alley between barns (connecting alley) – 24.4 m x 1.8 m

The co-permit holders shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that Act.

The co-permit holders shall adhere to the descriptions, the site plan, building plans and other attached documents included with filed Application RA24007.

The co-permit holders shall contact the NRCB at least 10 working days in advance of the desired inspection date to schedule the inspection in condition 3.

The co-permit holders are responsible for all costs associated with reporting requirements (this includes post construction reports).

Construction conditions

Finisher barn with connecting alley

1. The concrete used to construct the liner of the manure collection and storage portions of the finisher barn with connecting alley to meet the specifications for category B (liquid manure shallow pits), and category C (solid manure – wet) in Technical Guideline Agdex 096-93 “Non-Engineered Concrete Liners for Manure Collection and Storage Areas.”
2. The co-permit holders shall provide documentation to confirm the specifications of the concrete used to construct the manure storage and collection portions of the finisher barn and connecting alley.
3. The co-permit holders shall not place livestock or manure in the finisher barn or connecting alley until the facilities have been inspected by NRCB personnel and confirmed by them, in writing, to have been constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this permit.
4. The co-permit holders shall complete construction of the finisher barn with connecting alley prior to November 30, 2027. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.



This authorization becomes effective immediately and needs to be read in conjunction with Approval RA05011, Approval RA05011A, and Authorizations RA13023 and RA17019. Authorization RA24007 conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.
