Water Well Monitoring Requirements

The purpose of this statement is to outline the water well monitoring requirements in Approval RA24029. Ongoing condition 6 of Approval RA24029 reads:

“Drinking water quality tests for chlorides and nitrates must be conducted annually on the water well(s) within 100m of the confined feeding operation with the results submitted to the NRCB by September 30, beginning in 2014, unless otherwise directed in writing by the NRCB.”

The previous water well(s) that were within 100m of the confined feeding operation have been decommissioned. However, the condition remains in the event that new water wells are drilled.

It is the permit holders' responsibility to notify the NRCB if new water well(s) are drilled within 100m of a manure storage area or a manure collection area.

Therefore; the water well monitoring requirements for this facility shall be as follows:

Monitoring Frequency

Suspended, as the previous water wells were decommissioned.

Water Well Test Parameters

Suspended, as the previous water wells were decommissioned.

Water Wells to be used for Monitoring

Suspended, as the previous water wells were decommissioned.

These monitoring requirements become effective on the date of this statement and supersede any previously issued monitoring requirements at this facility.
