RE: Compliance Directive CD24-01 2nd Extension Letter

On July 30, 2024, Cecil Klassen requested an extension in writing from the NRCB to extend the deadline date of CD24-01, from August 1, 2024, to October 1, 2024, to complete the closure cleanup of pen 12. This email was further to a telephone discussion July 22, 2024, between Cecil and myself. Cecil advised clay had been hauled in to reconstruct the berm in pen 12 located along the east side of the surface run-off interceptor, a requirement of Directive # 2 in Compliance Directive CD24-01. Due to wet weather conditions, the berm had not been completed and pen 12 had not been decommissioned.

On July 11, 2024, Approval Officer Sarah Neff deemed the application complete for an NRCB permit for the construction of pen 11 (150' x 1000'). The additional information section of the part two permit application reads "Decommission north pen and rebuild berm before August 1, 2024".

On September 13, 2024, Approval Officer Sarah Neff confirmed that pen 12 had been decommissioned and the berm reconstructed along the east side of the surface run-off interceptor.

On September 30, 2024, Approval Officer Sarah Neff advised more time was required to address the surface water requirements (e.g., catch basin capacity and assessment of the existing liner) before issuing a permit.

As the operator has met all other requirements of Compliance Directive CD24-01, other than issuance of a permit, subject to the Approval Officer's decision, I am granting an extension until **November 1, 2024**, to meet this requirement of Compliance Directive CD24-01.

In the interim, Beaver Valley Cattle Co. Ltd., shall mitigate any possible risks to the environment and potential nuisances to any affected neighbours.
