

# Notice of Application

## Confined Feeding Operation

Homeland Colony Farming Company Ltd. have filed Application FA24002 with the Natural Resources Conservation Board (NRCB) to obtain an Approval to expand an existing confined feeding operation (CFO) on SEC 32-74-22 W5M in the M.D. of Smoky River of Alberta. The application is to construct a new layer barn, increase from 20,000 to 45,000 chicken layers (plus associated pullets), 10,000 to 15,000 pullets, and remove sheep and swine. This will bring the total permitted livestock at this CFO to 45,000 poultry layers (plus associated pullets), 20,000 turkey toms, 15,000 pullets, 1,000 ducks, 6,000 broilers, 500 geese, 200 finisher beef and 200 milking cows (plus dries and replacements).

### Filing a Response

Any person who is directly affected by the application may submit a written response to the NRCB. The response must be received by the NRCB on or before **4:30 pm on February 27, 2025**. Submissions should be made to the NRCB address provided below. All attachments sent electronically must be in pdf format. A copy of the responses will be sent to the applicant for comment. Responses regarding the application may be posted on the NRCB's public website, as they are public records and are non-confidential.

Your written response must include your name, the legal land description of your residence or landholdings, mailing address, phone number, and email. You must also explain how you are directly affected. Failure to submit a written response affects your right to apply for an NRCB Board review.
