Please be advised that Application LA25021 for the expansion at an existing multi species confined feeding operation has been approved.

Enclosed you will find a copy of the decision with respect to the application. In accordance with the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA), copies of the decision are being provided to all directly affected parties and to all parties determined not directly affected that provided written input to the Natural Resources Conservation Board. Also enclosed is the detailed technical review of the application.

All directly affected parties, which includes you and the MD of Acadia, and Special Areas 3, have the right under AOPA to request that the Natural Resources Conservation Board (the Board) review this decision. A written request must contain:

- a) a clear and concise statement of the facts relevant to the application
- b) the grounds on which the request for review is made
- c) a brief explanation as to the nature of the prejudice or damage that has resulted or will result from the order, decision or direction
- d) a brief description of the remedy sought
- e) your name, address, telephone number and, if available, e-mail address
- f) if you have a representative, the representative's name, address, telephone number and, if available, e-mail address

The request for Board review (RFR) must be received no later than 4:30 pm on the filing deadline of May 29, 2025.

Note: One possible outcome of a Board review is that your permit could be overturned. Any steps you take to construct or populate, before any Board proceeding is over, is entirely at your own risk.
