Reason(s), background and investigation (brief explanation of the issue):

On June 18, 2025, Cornelius (Cor) Jansen contacted the NRCB and requested a letter regarding the permit status of his dairy operation as it is pending sale. When I inquired if there have been any changes to the dairy since NRCB Authorization BA02005 was issued in 2002, Cor told me that there was a 60-foot addition built onto the east side of the dairy barn in 2020. I advised that a permit would be needed for this addition.

On June 24, 2025, Approval Officer Nathan Shirley and myself conducted an inspection at Cor Jansen's dairy operation. We inspected the site including the 2020 dairy barn addition and confirmed that this addition requires an NRCB permit.

Note: This is not a formal grandfathering determination, and the status of deemed livestock capacity (animal numbers) will need to be addressed in the course of a permitting process.

Directive: To mitigate any possible risks to the environment and potential nuisances to any affected neighbours, you or the current permit holder shall take all necessary and appropriate measures to comply with the following directive(s):

- 1) If, by January 1, 2026, an NRCB permit for the use of the east dairy barn addition as a manure collection area has not been obtained, all livestock and manure must be removed from the east dairy barn addition.

Any of the deadline dates contained above may be extended in writing, but only by the NRCB, at the sole discretion of the NRCB.

All actions required above shall be in compliance with AOPA and its regulations and shall not violate any other law.

The NRCB may access the land and structures for the purpose of assessing compliance with this directive.

NOTICE: Any issues determined to be outstanding may result in further enforcement action as per the NRCB Compliance and Enforcement Policy
