

In consideration of Decision Summary RA25037, Authorization RA25037 is issued to:

Permitted construction (based on the submitted site plan):

• Gilt barn – 64 m x 17.4 m x 0.6 m deep

The permit holder shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that Act.

The permit holder shall adhere to the descriptions, the site plan, building plans, and other attached documents included with filed Application RA25037.

The permit holder shall contact the NRCB at least 10 working days in advance of the desired inspection date to schedule the inspection in condition 2.

The permit holder is responsible for all costs associated with monitoring, sampling, testing, recording, and reporting requirements (this includes post construction reports).

Construction conditions

Gilt barn

- 1. The concrete used to construct the liner of the manure collection and storage portions of the new gilt barn to meet the specifications for category B (liquid manure shallow pits) in Technical Guideline Agdex 096-93 "Non-Engineered Concrete Liners for Manure Collection and Storage Areas". The permit holder shall provide documentation to confirm the specifications of the concrete used to construct the manure storage and collection portions of the gilt barn. This document must be provided to the NRCB prior to the inspection referenced in condition 2, below, or by a later date stated by the NRCB.
- 2. The permit holder shall not place livestock or manure in the new gilt barn until the facility has been inspected by NRCB personnel and confirmed by them, in writing, to have been constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this permit.
- 3. The permit holder shall complete construction of the gilt barn prior to November 30, 2026. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.

Facility decommissioning

4. The permit holder shall decommission the western half of barn 1 in accordance with Technical Guideline Agdex 096-90 "Closure of Manure Storage Facilities and Manure Collection Areas". The decommissioned facility must be inspected by NRCB personnel prior to constructing the new gilt barn.



This authorization becomes effective immediately and needs to be read in conjunction with Kingdom Farms' deemed approval, including Lacombe County Development Permit No. 113/97, and previously issued NRCB Authorizations RA14024B and RA19040. The authorization conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.
