Permitted construction (based on the submitted site plan):

- Broiler barn 2 – 114.3 m x 19.8 m

The co-permit holders shall comply with the requirements of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act* (AOPA) and the regulations passed pursuant to that Act.

The co-permit holders shall adhere to the descriptions, the site plan, building plans and other attached documents included with filed Application RA25047.

The co-permit holders shall contact the NRCB at least 10 working days in advance of the desired inspection date to schedule the inspection in condition 2.

The co-permit holders are responsible for all costs associated with monitoring, sampling, testing, recording, and reporting requirements (this includes post construction reports).

Construction conditions

Broiler barn 2

1. The concrete used to construct the liner of the manure collection and storage portions of broiler barn 2 to meet the specifications for category D (solid manure - dry) in Technical Guideline Agdex 096-93 “Non-Engineered Concrete Liners for Manure Collection and Storage Areas.” The co-permit holders shall provide documentation to confirm the specifications of the concrete used to construct the manure storage and collection portions of broiler barn 2. This document must be provided to the NRCB prior to the inspection referenced in condition 2, below, or by a later date stated by the NRCB.
2. The co-permit holders shall not place livestock or manure in the new broiler barn 2 until the facility has been inspected by NRCB personnel and confirmed by them, in writing, to have been constructed in accordance with the terms and conditions of this permit.
3. The co-permit holders shall complete construction of broiler barn 2 prior to May 31, 2027. Upon request, this deadline may be extended by the NRCB in writing.

This registration becomes effective immediately. The registration conditions will remain in effect unless amended in writing by the NRCB.



Klassen's deemed registration, including Kneehill County Development Permit #564-82, is therefore superseded and its content consolidated into this Registration RA25047, unless Registration RA25047 is held invalid following a review and decision by the NRCB's board members or by a court, in which case Kneehill County Development Permit #564-82 will remain in effect.
