2. Under section 29(1)(a) of the *Agricultural Operation Practices Act (AOPA)*, we are requesting / consenting to the **cancellation** of the CFO permit(s) at the legal land location indicated above.

3. We understand that:

- a. Upon permit cancellation, the CFO can no longer be used to confine and feed livestock unless a new permit is issued.
- b. We must contact the NRCB *before* we construct any new, or renovate old existing, facilities that were subject to this cancellation or have not been used to house livestock in the past.
- c. The NRCB may include terms and conditions in a cancellation. The NRCB will advise us of any terms and conditions.
- d. We must comply with any conditions of the cancellation.
- e. The NRCB may notify municipalities or other parties of the cancellation.
- f. If not already done, we must remove manure, compost and composting materials from the land or buildings within one year or by a shorter or longer term set by the NRCB. This should be done in accordance with NRCB Technical Guideline Agdex 096-90 "Closure of Manure Storage Facilities and Manure Collection Areas."
- g. We must contact the NRCB *before* placing livestock (above AOPA threshold limits) on the land or in the buildings.
